Last week we went to Washington, D.C. for a conference called "Words, Music and Spirit," led by Don and Emily Saliers. We met at the Washington National Cathedral at the College of Preachers. This was a time of learning for me, but the richness of the week far exceeded the things I learned. The relationships forged between the 30 attendees was deeply renewing for me. I networked with people from all over the nation. I met an associate minister from a thriving Disciples church in Olathe, Kansas. Only 16 years old, this congregation is vibrant and purposeful. I met another minister from a United Methodist church in Cambridge, Massachusetts. This congregation is a glowing witness for Christ on the campus of Harvard University. There were ministers and lay persons at the conference who were from churches of 40 persons and others from congregations of thousands. I even reconnected with an Episcopal priest from Decatur, Georgia who had been one of my Greek students over 20 years ago. Each participant had an exciting story to tell about what life in Christ means. It was a joy to hear those stories, and to share my own. Thanks for giving me that privilege.
